Subject: Nursing Home and Nursing Home Type Patient Fees

As a result of the increase in the standard rate pension from 23 September 1993, the patient contribution for nursing home residents and nursing home type patients has been increased from \$23.70 to \$24.00. As a result of this change the fees for nursing home and nursing home type patients from 23 September 1993, will be as follows:

**NURSING HOME REVENUES (FEE PER DAY (\$))**

**1. Resident Fee Revenue**

a) Non CAM/SAM Homes - Resident Fee \$24

The additional fee payable by residents of non CAM/SAM nursing homes whose income is above the pension level is a maximum of \$14 per day. This additional fee is subject to an assessment of a resident's financial status.

b) CAM Modified SAM Homes- Resident Fee \$24

**2. Commonwealth Revenues**

a) Non CAM/SAM Homes:

Basic benefit \$48.50

Extensive Care (where applicable) \$6

b) CAM Modified SAM Homes

RCI 1 - 5 (including interim rate) depending on individual classification \$79.92 - \$27.33

Modified SAM \$27.71

OCRE \$6

Patient Contribution (all patients) of \$24 is deducted by the Commonwealth from the CAM Modified SAM fees and the balance is paid by the Commonwealth.


**NURSING HOME TYPE PATIENTS FEE PER DAY (\$)**

Basic accommodation charge (private patients) 61.56


Extensive Care (private patients - where applicable) 6.00
